## TIM GOSLING COLLECTION

Renowned rug producers, The Rug Company, have welcomed another name to its roster of collaborators this month, in the form of British designer Tim Gosling.

Drawing influence from the Art Deco era, with its geometric lines and patterns featuring in each, the two new hand-knotted Tibetan wool and silk rugs Tim has designed were woven entirely by hand using ancient techniques in the company's weaving houses in Kathmandu, Nepal.

Named Empire and Deco Border; both rugs take design cues from the 1930s, with Italian architecture key to the former, and paneled walls of the era evident in the latter.

Gosling explains the use of colours in the Deco Border rug: 'I particularly wanted to get a silk bronze into this rug to work with interior colours that we're now using and that have become so popular again.'
