Felt

Felt's handmade Shyrdaks offer an array of different shades of red, ranging from bright geranium to deep maroon, combined with traditional geometric designs. The rugs are created in hand-sewn layers and made from 100% wool by the nomadic people of the remote Tien Shan mountains in Kyrgyzstan. The rugs come in a range of sizes, from runners to room size.

Knots Rugs

Knots Rugs presents two new carpets in collaboration with Blackpop. Using a multitude of colours, the hand-knotted rugs - called Fresco and Capriccio - are produced in Nepal and are made from a mixture of Tibetan wool and Chinese silk. The rugs are licensed with the Sir John Soane's Museum, London.

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Christopher Farr & Collett-Zarzycki

Collett-Zarzycki introduces a custom-made rug design in collaboration with Christopher Farr. The pattern has been developed from a series of works on paper created by Georgia Collett, senior designer and graduate of both Central Saint Martins and the Royal College of Art. The broad, sweeping brush strokes are translated into a fine, hand-knotted wool carpet measuring 3 x 4m.

In response to the Pantone Colour of the Year for 2019, the carded rug - knotted by hand - is made from Himalayan wool, pure silk, and uses vegetable colour.
